Update: On Friday, June 5, 2015, at approximately 5:45 p.m., Suspect Jose Bonilla Rodas was arrested without incident in the City of South San Francisco by the SJPD Covert Response Unit. Rodas was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for Involuntary Manslaughter.

The investigation revealed Victim Esquivel was inside the Myth Taverna and Lounge. Esquivel went outside and got into an argument with Rodas who was working as a bouncer. Rodas punched Esquivel. Esquivel fell to the ground and was knocked unconscious. Friends loaded Esquivel into a car and drove off. Esquivel remained unconscious and friends drove Esquivel to Stanford Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

San Jose: On Saturday, March 28, 2015, at approximately 4:50 a.m., the Palo Alto Police Department (PAPD) requested

assistance from the San Jose Police Department (SJPD). PAPD advised an adult male was driven to Stanford hospital with head trauma. Medical staff pronounced the victim dead.

Preliminary investigation indicates the victim was involved in a fight at the Myth Taverna & Lounge, located in the 100 block of Post St. in San Jose. The victim was dropped off at Stanford hospital a few hours later where he was pronounced dead.

Investigators would like witnesses to contact them with any information regarding the fight or victim's whereabouts after he left the club. No other details are available.

The San Jose Police Department in collaboration with the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office and Wal-Mart are pleased to announce its use of an online "Shoplifter Release Pilot Program".

The goal of the program is to utilize an online shoplifter reporting system that creates a partnership between the business victim and the police department. This collaboration will allow the business victim to process a suspected shoplifter more efficiently. Officers would still be available to respond to the business victim under certain circumstances. The resulting benefit will allow patrol officers to answer higher priority calls for service and follow up on community policing projects citywide.

The program will pilot for at least six months exclusively at the 777 Story Road, Wal-Mart store. Other San Jose Wal-Mart stores will not be participating during the initial pilot phase. We would like to thank Wal-mart for agreeing to participate in this program. The San Jose Police Department will monitor the program and re-evaluate the viability after the six month trial period.

The San Jose Police Department will be deploying roving DUI patrols this St. Patrick's Day looking to stop and arrest drivers who are impaired by alcohol or drugs. These DUI patrols are, in addition to regularly scheduled patrol officers, all looking for the tell-tale signs of an impaired driver behind the wheel.

In 2013, there were 31 people killed in drunk-driving crashes on St. Patrick's Day. All in all, during the St. Patty's Day period from 2009 to 2013, there have been 276 drunk-driving fatalities. Every one of those lives was lost because of bad decisions. Unfortunately, March 17 has become a deadly day in the United States, with a dramatic spike in drunk-driving fatalities. And we're not just talking about a little bit too much to drink here; from 2009 to 2013, almost three-fourths of the drunk-driving fatalities on St. Patrick's Day involved drivers who were twice the legal limit.

The San Jose Police Department offered this advice to partygoers: Get ahead of the decision this year. If you know you're going to celebrate St. Patrick's Day with alcohol, then figure out a plan ahead of time for how you'll get home. Don't wait until you're too buzzed to decide, and don't let your friends drive drunk. Buzzed Driving Is Drunk Driving, so if you have anything to drink, count on a sober friend, taxi, or public transportation to drive you home safely. Not drinking? Maybe this St. Patrick's Day, you'll be the saint who drives your friends sober.

Let's make 2015 different. Use this party-planning checklist to stay safe this St. Patrick's Day.

DDVIP: The California Office of Traffic Safety DDVIP app is now available for free download on iOS and Android devices. Launched last year the new DDVIP app offers enhanced features, allowing users to Map a Spot with their current location to find DDVIP partnering establishments in their area or a List of Spots to search all participating bars and restaurants throughout California. Users can stay up-to-date with the latest from DDVIP and see what other users are saying via its social tab. Also through the app, for those who want to imbibe but also make it a point to plan ahead, users can easily order a sober ride from Uber, Lyft or Curb all from one screen.

- NOW: Even if you don't have plans yet, plan to drive sober or designate someone else to. Save the number of a taxi company in your phone so you always have a backup plan.
- WHEN YOU MAKE PLANS: A sober driver is an essential part of any party plan. Once you know where you'll celebrate, decide whether you're drinking or driving. You can only choose one.
- ON ST. PATRICK'S DAY: Before you take your first sip of green beer, leave your keys at home or give them to a friend. If you're the designated driver, don't drink. Enjoy non-alcoholic beverages and brag about your VIP (very important partygoer) status online using the #designateddriver. Only drive sober or ride with a sober driver.
- EVERY DAY: If you're impaired, use a taxi, call a sober friend or family member, or use public transportation to get home safely. If you know people who are about to drive or ride while impaired, take their keys and help them make other arrangements to get to where they are going safely.
- DRUGS, MEDICATION & ALCOHOL= CRASHES: Recent statistics reveal that 30 percent of drivers in fatal crashes had one or more drugs in their systems. The San Jose Police Department is investigating a fatal hit and run traffic collision. On Saturday, February 28, 2015, at approximately 3:13 AM, officers responded to the area of Hillsdale Avenue and Meridian Avenue on a report of a hit and run traffic collision. In 2013, the FBI implemented an important change in the Uniform Crime Reporting Programs definition of rape. The newly revised definition of Rape is:

Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.

Under the new definition, the FBI UCR Program will aggregate three sex offenses in the definition of Rape. In California the three offenses that will be included in the Rape definition are:

- Sodomy
- Oral Copulation
- Penetration with a Foreign Object

The California Department of Justice gave all California agencies until January 1, 2015 to modify their current data collection systems to comply with the new UCR definition. As of January 1, 2015, the San Jose Police Department will now adhere to the new UCR definition of Rape to align with the FBIs Uniform Crime Reporting Program.

As a result, any year to year UCR comparisons which include 2015 should note this change. Additionally, we will not have a meaningful yearly comparison in the category of Rape until the end of 2016.

San Jose, CA -- San Jose Police Department Traffic Unit will be conducting a DUI/Drivers License Checkpoint on Friday, December 19, 2014 at an undisclosed location within the city limit between the hours of 8:00 pm to 2:00 am.

The deterrent effect of DUI checkpoints is a proven resource in reducing the number of persons killed and injured in alcohol or drug involved crashes. Research shows that crashes involving an impaired driver can be reduced by up to 20 percent when well-publicized DUI checkpoints and proactive DUI patrols are conducted routinely.

In California, this deadly crime led to 802 deaths in 2012 because someone failed to designate a sober driver. Nationally, the latest data shows nearly 10,000 were killed by an impaired driver. Over the course of the past three years, DUI collisions have claimed 8 lives and resulted in injury crashes harming 462 of our friends and neighbors, said Sgt Steve Payne.

Officers will be looking for signs of alcohol and/or drug impairment with officers checking drivers for proper licensing delaying motorists only momentarily. When possible, specially trained officers will be available to evaluate those suspected of drug-impaired driving. Recent statistics reveal that 30 percent of drivers in fatal crashes had one or more drugs in their systems. A study of active drivers showed more tested positive for drugs that may impair driving (14 percent) than did for alcohol (7.3 percent). Of the drugs, marijuana was most prevalent, at 7.4 percent, slightly more than alcohol.

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), checkpoints have provided the most effective documented results of any of the DUI enforcement strategies, while also yielding considerable cost savings of \$6 for every \$1 spent. Nearly 90 percent of California drivers approve of DUI checkpoints.

DUI Checkpoints are placed in locations based on collision statistics and frequency of DUI arrests affording the greatest opportunity for achieving drunk and drugged driving deterrence. Locations are chosen with safety considerations for the officers and the public.

Drivers caught driving impaired can expect the impact of a DUI arrest to include jail time, fines, fees, DUI classes, other expenses

that can exceed \$10,000 not to mention the embarrassment when friends and family find out.

Funding for this checkpoint is provided to San Jose Police Department by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, reminding everyone to Report Drunk Driver Call 9-1-1.
