## **OPERATIONS SUPPORT SERVICES DIVISION POLICE CLEARANCE LETTER REQUEST — INSTRUCTIONS AND APPLICATION**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Police Clearance Letters are issued only for purposes related to immigration or international travel. You must be a current or former resident of the City of San José to submit a request.

## REQUIREMENTS

- A copy of valid government-issued photo identification must be included with your request.
- A non-refundable fee of \$24.00 per letter is required.
  - Checks must be made payable to "City of San José."
- The completed Police Clearance Letter will be mailed to the current address you provide on the request form.

**NOTE:** If a San José Police Department arrest record exists, Immigration Clearance Letters will be mailed directly to the United States Department of Homeland Security – Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).
